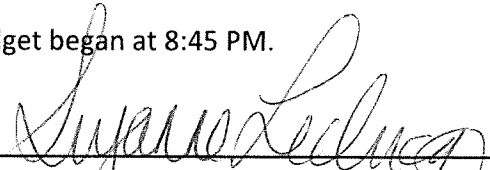
Darwin Naccarato was appointed and the City's newest Councilmember.

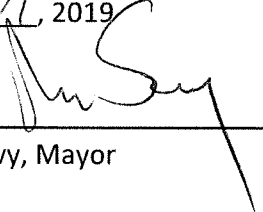
Mayor Levy thanked all of the candidates for their applications and encouraged them to run for office for the April 7, 2020 Municipal Election.
