



**Parks and Recreation Advisory Board
October 12, 2022 Minutes**

I. Call to Order and Roll Call

- a. In Jeff's absence, and at Teri's request, Cindy agreed to lead the meeting.
- b. Members present were Teri Baldwin, Danuta Brown, Don Dezellem, Kathy Evans, Jerry Smith and Sue Janicki. Member Jeff Webb was absent.
- c. City Council Liaison Kellie Case and staff member Cindy Keating were present.

II. Approval of Minutes

- a. Don motioned to approve the August 10 minutes. Sue seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

III. Reports

- a. Cindy reviewed the August/September monthly report, Highlights included the following:
 - i. There was large response to the PTOS engagement survey;
 - ii. A tentative approval is in place for fireworks at the City's Christmas parade;
 - iii. Wind damage to the hockey rink has resulted in playing hockey at the facility this winter in jeopardy;
 - iv. P&R offices are being relocated to the Teen Center, hopefully by end of October.
 - v. Planning is in full swing for the HALLOW-PALOOZA event scheduled for Friday/Saturday October 28 & 29.
- b. Cindy advised that Brady Warner was recognized as the Colorado Parks & Recreation Association Aquatics Center Manager of the Year – Congrats to Brady!

IV. Old Business

- a. Update PARB by-laws were formally approved by City Council and made effective on August 18, 2022.

V. New Business

- a. **Board Secretary:** Don motioned that Jerry be appointed as the new Secretary; Teri seconded. Motion carried 6-0.
- b. **PRTOS Community Engagement Survey:**
 - i. Cindy provided a summary of results from the recently completed Community Engagement Survey conducted in support of the new PRTOS Master Plan.
 - 1. Participation in the survey was very high, better than expected.
 - 2. Pickleball Courts and Hiking/Trail Development were far and away the most mentioned areas of interest.
 - 3. In general, and other than Pickleball and Hiking, there was a somewhat high level of disinterest in participation in other programs. Some interest in a few outdoor activities but not much.
 - ii. Cindy will contact City of Breckenridge P&R and local Teller County Trail Association representative to develop more information on how best to approach NFS about trail development in National Forests.
